

CTET Syllabus 2024

CTET syllabus for paper I and paper II is outlined in the official notification released by CBSE. Students can make a preparation plan for the teacher eligibility exam based on the syllabus. Aspirants preparing for the exam must cover all the topics outlined in the syllabus in order to perform well. The detailed syllabus for Paper I and Paper II is given below:

CTET Paper I Syllabus

CTET Paper II Syllabus

1. Child Development and Pedagogy Syllabus- 30 Questions

The topic is common in both papers 1 and 2 and it is even compulsory to attempt. Candidates will be able to cover the topic of Child Development and the Concept of Inclusive education.

- Understanding the Idea of inclusive education and kids with special needs: 5 questions
- Learning and Pedagogy: 10 Questions

Language I Syllabus- 30 Questions

- Language Comprehension: 15 Questions
- Pedagogy of Language Development: 15 Questions

III. Language II Syllabus- 30 Questions

The second language examination will check the candidate's proficiency with the English language. In both Paper-I and Paper-II of the CTET, there will be 30 problems.

- Comprehension: 15 Questions
- Pedagogy of Language Development: 15 Questions

1. (A) Mathematics and Science Syllabus- 60 Questions

The candidates can check the topics to be covered in the Mathematics and Science section. The questions of Maths should be attempted with tricks and accuracy. There will be 30 questions from Maths and 30 from Science subjects.

Mathematics: 30 Questions

- Content: 20 Questions
- Pedagogical issues: 10 Questions

Science: 30 Questions

1. a) Content: 20 Questions

2. Social Studies/Social Sciences Syllabus- 60 Questions

In this subject, the topics are divided into two parts: One includes History, Geography, and Social & Political Life and the Second one includes Pedagogical issues. The ratio of questions will be 40:20 respectively.

1. History

2. Geography

Though it is challenging for anyone to fully comprehend India's terrain unless they dig deeper into it. For CTET Paper-II, CBSE has added a Geography topic, though.

III. Social and Political Life

Through this section, the candidate's knowledge about the surrounding and the topics.

1. b) Pedagogical issues

There will be 20 questions from this section and the motive of this section will be to understand the candidate's intelligence and presence of mind for Pedagogical issues.

CTET Cut-Off 2024

CTET cut-off refers to the minimum marks scored by a candidate and it will be released by the CBSE. Candidates should note that the cut-off for the teacher eligibility exam varies for different categories.

Both CTET papers I and II are 150 marks and candidates who belong to the general category are required to score marks equal to or more than 90, whereas OBC? SC/ST category candidates need to score 82 out of 150 marks.

Conclusion

Candidates aspiring to appear for the CTET exam 2024 should make their preparation rock solid in order to clear the teacher eligibility test. The CTET admit cards are usually released 10 days before the exam and the document contains all the information about the exam.
